Relational	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Model high expectations and aspirations for staff and students in relation to the pedagogy and content, challenging underperformance or low expectations ● Plan and coordinate opportunities for professional learning and staff engagement regarding digital technologies ● Promote parental understanding and engagement with digital technologies ● Support the engagement of learning area staff with College's performance and development framework with a focus on the pedagogy and content of the learning area (coaching, mentoring, feedback, goal setting)
Strategic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Lead the development, implementation and monitoring of the new digital technologies curriculum through reviewing current curriculum opportunities and new possibilities ● Contribute to the development, implementation and monitoring of the annual learning and teaching action plans ● Ensure alignment of learning area pedagogy and content with the College values, graduate outcomes and Learning and Teaching Framework in collaboration with relevant Learning Community Leaders
