



# Uniform Guide



# What you need to know

Students are expected to wear full school uniform each day. On days where students are undertaking Physical Education (PE) or Physical Education electives (from Year 9) the student should wear their full PE uniform.

Students should wear either the academic or the PE uniform. A combination of both uniforms is considered out of uniform.

## Out of uniform procedure

All parents should provide a note (or email) to their child's TA teacher explaining the reason for their child being out of uniform.

### Students in F-4

Parents will receive a notification if their child has presented at school out of uniform without a note. The expectation is that this would be rectified as soon as possible.

### Students in 5-12

Students who present out of uniform without a note will likely be required to attend uniform detention (at lunchtime). Parents will be notified of this. The expectation is that this would be rectified as soon as possible.

If any assistance (financial) is required for uniform, parents should communicate this to their child's TA.

If a student presents at the college out of uniform three times or more within a fortnight, parents will be required to attend a meeting at the college to rectify this situation.

When enrolling students at the college, parents acknowledge that a condition of enrolment is to adhere to the college's policies (including uniform) and procedures.

## Non uniform items

- Hoodies and jumpers over and under uniforms
- Visible undershirts under uniform
- Caps, beanies, non school uniform hats

## School hats

To be worn when outside from week 7 of Term 3, all of Term 4 and Term 1, and Term 2 until ANZAC day. This is consistent with our Sunsmart policy.

A beanie and scarf is able to be worn in Terms 2 and 3. Beanies should be worn outdoors only. These items are available from the college office.

## Jewellery and grooming

The following items of jewellery may be worn; one watch, up to two sets of ear studs or sleepers (no pendant earrings), one simple necklace, one bracelet and one simple ring.

A simple necklace is defined as a fine chain which may have a simple cross or equivalent. Headbands, ribbons and scarves should be navy blue or burgundy.

For piercings (other than ears), a small clear stud should be worn.

Excessive make-up, coloured nail polish, fake nails, fake eyelashes and extreme hair colour are not permitted.

Tattoos should not be visible.
